NATIONWIDE ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Federal, State, And Local Elections

1. US Citizenship

You Must Be A Citizen Of The United States. Non-Citizens (Including Lawful Permanent Residents) Cannot Register For Federal Elections.



2. Age



You Must Be 18 Years Old On Or Before Election Day. Some States Allow Pre-Registration If You're Younger, But You May Only Vote Once You Turn 18.

3. Residency

You Must Meet Your State's Residency Rules (You Must Live In The State Where You Are Registering).



4. Registration Requirement



With The Exception Of North Dakota (Which Does Not Have Voter Registration) You Must Be Registered To Vote In The State Where You Live Before Voting.



Note: Some Individuals With Prior Felony Convictions Or Certain Court Determinations May Have Different Eligibility Requirements Depending On State Law. Check With Your Local Election Office For Specific Guidance.
