

MOVED, CHANGED YOUR NAME, TURNING 18?

What you need to know to stay registered to vote



WHY THIS MATTERS



- Your voter registration must **match your current information**
- Moving, changing your name, or turning 18 **can affect eligibility**
- Staying updated ensures you can **vote without issues**

IF YOU MOVED



- Update your registration in your **new address**
- Can often do **online, by mail, or in person**
- **Check your state's** official voter registration website



IF YOU'RE TURNING 18



- **Must be 18 on or before** election day to vote
- Can **pre-register** in many states (if offered)
- **Check registration deadlines** well before your birthday



IF YOU'VE CHANGED YOUR NAME



- Happens after **marriage, divorce, or legal name change**
- **Update registration** to reflect your new name
- Use **official state forms** (online or mail-in)



HOW TO CHECK YOUR REGISTRATION



- You can [check your registration status](#) online
- Information is based on **official state voter data**
- Make sure your address, name, and **eligibility info are correct**
- **Avoid surprises** on election day

KEY TAKEAWAYS



- **Keep your registration current** if you move, change your name, or turn 18
- **Check your registration status regularly**
- **Use official resources** — it's simple, safe, and nonpartisan
