PERSONAL ENGAGEMENT

CIVIC PARTICIPATION

(Individual Capacity)

The following activities should be pursued in a personal capacity, not on behalf of a church or nonprofit organization.

- Consider running for local, state, or national office
- Support civic causes or candidates in your personal capacity
- Take on leadership roles in civic or community organizations
- Attend candidate forums and public hearings to stay informed
- Encourage others to participate responsibly in the civic process.

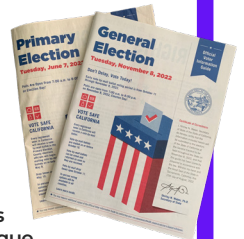


COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

- Start or lead a local prayer group
- Encourage nonpartisan voter registration and civic participation
- Disciple and equip emerging leaders in your community
- Connect with your faith-based or family-focused organizations for community engagement
- Engage the next generation through mentoring, youth programs, or discipleship
- Serve as a Deputy Voter Registrar (where permitted by law) to help others participate in elections
- Volunteer in community service projects that reflect your faith

ISSUE EDUCATION & AWARENESS

- Learn deeply about issues you care about
- Communicate respectfully with elected officials as a private citizen
- Participate in educational discussions around values-based issues.
- Organize awareness campaigns or community forums on key issues
- Write articles, blogs, or share perspectives and encourage others to thoughtful dialogue



CHURCH LEADERSHIP

- Launch a prayer group or Bible study within your church
- Encourage pastors and leaders teach biblical values
- Share educational resources with church leadership to equip your congregation
- Serve as the point person for civic engagement or voter education efforts
- Organize workshops or seminars on spiritual and civic responsibility
